Dear Veteran:

The National Disabled Veterans Golf Clinic (NDVGC) strives to provide an adaptive golf and rehabilitation program for Veterans with qualifying disabilities via adaptive activities. Provision of this program serves to engage and invigorate Veterans with disabilities to directly improve their physical, mental, and emotional well-being by introducing Veterans to the game of golf, adaptive options for playing and instruction from PGA and LPGA professionals, as well as an introduction to several alternative activities and sports. Participating in the golf instruction and golf programming each day is required.

Participation in the NDVGC is open to military service Veterans who are eligible for VA health care with qualifying disabilities such as visual impairments, spinal cord injuries, amputations, traumatic brain injuries, and certain neurological conditions.

All eligible Veterans, please fill out the application completely and return no later than April 4, 2025. Other national rehab events physical exam forms are acceptable, so long as they are within 1 year of the actual event (October 2024 or later).

- What is covered: Golf programming, lodging, and meals during the NDVGC dates (Sunday, September 7 to Friday, September 12). Dinner on Sunday, September 7 is the first meal provided. Breakfast on Friday, September 12 is the last meal provided by the clinic.
- What is NOT covered: Travel to and from Riverside, lowa, lodging and meals outside of the NDVGC dates listed above.
- It is highly encouraged you bring someone with you who can serve as your golf buddy.
 - If a volunteer (golf buddy) is attending with you, they <u>MUST</u> fill out a volunteer application.
 - Volunteer applications can be found at www.veteransgolfclinic.org/volunteer.
- Veterans will be responsible for bringing all required prescriptions and durable medical equipment (DME) - this includes shower chairs, toilet risers, braces, etc.
- There will be NO dog sitting program offered.

The clinic involves several consecutive days of golfing and alternative activities that are rigorous. If you are accepted, please ensure you build your endurance ahead of the clinic.


